TROPHY BUFFALO BULL

- **Great size.** Mounted buffalo bull stands seven feet high and eight feet long.
- **Prime condition.** Shot on a cold winter day of a cold winter in full coat, Jan. 3, 2009, on the Don Archibald ranch SE of Lodgepole.
- **Finely crafted.** Mounted by Randy Holler, Hettinger, national award-winning taxidermist and two-term president of the North Dakota Taxidermists Association, who donated half his services.
- **Natural setting.** Planned backdrop is large color mural of buffalo grazing the hills south of White Butte on Floyd Johnson ranch; photos by Donna Keller and Jim Strand.
- **Strong community support.** Costs of about \$10,000, entirely funded through donations and the Trophy Hunt raffle.
- **Honors local history.** Celebrates the last stand of the buffalo and the final hunts in 1882 and 1883 by native people, who hunted them here in traditional ways.
