Hettinger Elementary School

Hettinger Elementary is a PK-6th grade school with a current enrollment of 190 students which includes 35 preschool students. Preschool students are between the ages of three and five. Classes run two days per week either in the morning for two hours or in the afternoon for three hours. This is a public pre-school and we charge a small tuition fee to help support this program.

We have small class sizes with less than 25 students per classroom allowing students more attention from teachers. Title I Reading and Math programs along with a Creative Learners program are offered for students that need that extra help.

Our Kindergarten students attend five days a week all day starting the first of November and are reading and writing quite well at the end of their Kindergarten year. We have team teaching in grades 4-6 so students experience a learning environment which prepares them for junior high.

All of our K-6 students have Physical Education and Music five days a week. They have a technology class in the computer lab weekly. They also have library time weekly where they work on research skills and get library books.

Hettinger High School

Hettinger's secondary school consists of grades 7-12 and currently has 125 students enrolled. Benefits of the school include; an indoor pool, two ITV systems, a vocational agriculture shop, an auto shop, and a teacher to student ratio of 1 to 10. Our school is also one of the most technologically advanced schools in the region with over 150 networked computers, including three labs with 20 or more computers, 8 computers in the library, and at least one computer in every classroom. We also have Active Boards in our classrooms and next year we will be incorporating iPads into the classrooms as teaching tools. To better communicate with parents and students, teachers utilize individual websites for lesson plans and weekly events.

Even with reduced numbers we are currently staffed with two educators in the following fields: Math, English, Science, Business, Physical Education, and Vocational Technology classes. Enhancing our curriculum is our involvement in more than a 40 school interactive network to allow for an expanded course-offering list.

Our district is fortunate enough to have enrichment opportunities from our community members in the form of programs and guest speakers on a regular basis.
